THE PERSON

Anders 'Andy' Anderson was living on the hill before the mining settlement developed. His precise arrival date is not known.

02

THE DATE

Mineral Lease No. 773 was issued on 8 August 1887—the earliest exact date identified for the mining development that brought people together here.

03

THE COMMUNITY

Workers camped on the hill. A settlement formed around the mine. Brown Coal Mine grew and, in 1947, became Yallourn North.
